
Orature Software Settings Menu

Choose a light, dark, or system theme.


Orature defaults to the system theme.


Audio Device Settings

Choose the hardware for the microphone.




Language Settings

Click the 'Check for Updates' button to update the list of target languages.




Application Settings

Choose software for recording and for editing.


Click in the desired dot to make the choice.

Keyboard Shortcuts

This is a list of keyboard shortcuts.

Feel free to use these shortcuts instead of the mouse.

Focus – to see the menu item highlighted.

Select – select the menu item.

Navigation – move around the program.

Scroll Down – move down in the text windows.

Scroll up – move up in the text windows.


Go Back – move to the previous page/window/

Add Verse Maker – use this shortcut in the Verse Marker section.

Record/Stop Recording – use this shortcut instead of using the mouse click.

Play/Pause (Source) – use this shortcut on the Source audio instead of the mouse click.

Play/Pause (Target) – use this shortcut on the Target language audio instead of the mouse click.



Close Settings

Click on 'X'.
